Re: SGVCOG ED memo

The next meeting of the Governing Board of the SGVCOG is Thursday, October 20 at 6 p.m. I am sharing some information in advance of the meeting:

1. **SGVCOG General Assembly October 26:** The SGVCOG General Assembly is scheduled for Wednesday, October 26, at Pacific Palms hotel in the City of Industry. Doors open at 8:00 a.m. with the program starting at 8:45 a.m. The General Assembly will focus on transportation, with special presentations by Metro CEO Phil Washington, Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti, Supervisor Hilda Solis, Congressmembers Grace Napolitano and Judy Chu, Assemblymember Chris Holden and many other prominent officials.

The SGVCOG Leadership Awards will be presented during the lunch from 12 noon until 1:00 p.m., with an introduction by State Senator Bob Huff.

2. **Metrolink Quiet Zones:** Several cities met last week to discuss how they might work together to create a regional quiet zone that meets Federal requirements. Attendees were primarily from cities along the San Bernardino Metrolink line, but some cities along the Riverside Metrolink line also participated. The meeting was hosted by Larry Stevens, the Planning Director and Assistant City Manager of San Dimas. It is estimated that the quiet zones could cost about \$1 million per crossing, covering the cost of equipment and insurance. The cities will meet again to evaluate how they can coordinate their efforts for the full length of the Metrolink corridor. It is expected that the cities will schedule to meet with Metrolink later in the fall.
3. **Flight Pattern for airports:** The Federal Aviation Administration has made a final determination to approve new flight patterns for LAX and other regional airports in Southern California. Attached is the letter announcing their findings along with a schedule for public hearings to receive comment on the flight patterns (see attached).

4. **Merry Mingle December 8:** The combined holiday party of the SGVCOG and the SGV Economic Partnership will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, December 8, at the Rivergrade location in Irwindale. A formal notice will be sent in the next few weeks.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) signed a Finding of No Significant Impact and (FONSI) Record of Decision (ROD) for the Southern California Metroplex project on August 31, 2016. This is the FAA’s final decision, and it enables the agency to move forward with implementing the project, which will replace dozens of existing conventional air traffic control procedures with new satellite-based procedures. The project encompasses most of Southern California and includes six major airports and 15 satellite airports. We undertook the project to improve airspace safety and efficiency by allowing for more optimized and efficient routing of aircraft into and out of Southern California.

I’m writing to let you know the FAA is planning community outreach in support of the implementation of the project. The project is being implemented in phases and this outreach will be focused on communities where changes are occurring in November 2016. The community outreach will consist of both public information briefings and internet based webinars. Additional community outreach will be conducted in early 2017 for the subsequent implementation phases of the project, in which you will receive prior notification.

Public Information Briefings:

The public information briefings will be an open-house format where the public can attend anytime during the posted times to learn about the project. FAA representatives will provide a variety of information on the project and will be available to answer questions. The public is welcome to attend anytime during the posted times to learn more about the project. Free public parking is available at the briefing locations, and surrounding street parking is available too. Spanish interpreters will be present for the briefings.
