**DELINQUENT PENALTY:** A delinquent penalty is assessed at the rate of 20% of the license tax for each thirty (30) day period that the business license is delinquent past its expiration date. A delinquent penalty may not exceed 100% of the basic

**RENEWALS:** Renewal forms are mailed to each business whose license is due to expire. Your renewal notice will indicate the expiration date of the license. ***(Please note that renewal forms are mailed out as a courtesy. It is your responsibility to insure that your business license is current at all times).***

\* On September 19, 2012 Governor Brown signed into law SB-1186, which adds a state fee of \$1 on any applicant for a local business license or similar instrument or permit, or renewal thereof. The purpose is to increase disability access and compliance with construction-related accessibility requirements and to develop educational resources for businesses in order to facilitate compliance with federal and state disability laws, as specified.

**Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public.
