**How do I access these books on my tablet/phone/device?**

- You can now browse the Southern California Digital Library for e-books. You can search by fiction, non-fiction, kids & teens and featured collections.





- **OverDrive Read** for devices such as iPad, Kindle, and Nook
- **OverDrive Media Console** is for mobile devices like your iPhone and Android phone.
